4. The licence will be suspended from the date specified. The suspension start date must be on or after the date you submit the notice. You cannot suspend your licence retrospectively or after the expiry date of your licence.
5. If you are suspending for more than one year, please note you will have to pay the annual suspension fee each year. This is due on the anniversary date of the original suspension.
