**NOTES**

1. Section 44 of the Real Estate Agents Act 2008 requires that “a person must not, after the issue to him or her of an agent’s licence, enter in partnership with any person in respect of his or her business as an agent without the prior approval of the Authority; and the Authority must refuse to grant its approval unless it is satisfied that the proposed partner holds an agent’s licence.”
2. All the parties to the proposed partnership should be identified on this form and all should sign it. If there are more than two persons, provide additional details of proposed partners (name and licence registration number ) and signature as necessary.
